## **INSTRUCTIONS**

Before you begin, wipe a damp sponge over entire bisque to remove dust and contaminants.

- 1. Apply 1 thick coat of #62 all over the outside of the mug until no white is showing.
- 2. When the color has lost its shine, take a slightly damp sponge and gently wipe the color off the pottery. You want to wipe lightly, removing the color from just the raised parts of the texture. This will leave the color in just the cracks, giving it an antiqued look. For best results, continually rinse your sponge in your water bowl while you wipe, as needed, and squeeze out the water well so it doesn't drip onto your pottery.
- 3. Apply 3 coats of #104 on the hat band. Let each coat dry before moving on.
- 4. Paint 2 watery coats of #55 on the scarf and handle.
- 5. Paint 2 coats of #104 on the carrot nose.
- 6. Apply 3 coats of #45 on the hat.
- 7. Paint 2 coats of #31 on the eyes and mouth.
- 8. Paint 1 watery coat of #45 on the inside of the mug.
- 9. Using the back of the pencil like a stamp, make #104 dots on the scarf and handle.
- 10. With the end of the paint brush handle, add #67 dots for eye shine on the right side of each eye.
