# MATZO MOUSE PLATE



## MATERIALS

Hexagon Plate

Fan Brush

Matzo Mouse Pattern

NCR or tissue paper

Pen

Yellow Sponge

Small Shader Brush

## COLORS

CMM 88 - Vanilla Bean

CMM 12 - Mocha Java

CMM 15 - Mississippi Mud

CMM 105 - Storm

CMM 16 - Chiffon

CMM 44 - Battleship

CMM 11 - Blue Lagoon

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## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Use your fan brush to apply two coats of Vanilla Bean to the entire top of the plate.
2. After that dries, use your pen and NCR (or tissue paper) to trace on the Mouse pattern.
3. Use Mocha Java and apply the rows of texture to the Matzah to the background of the plate (working around the mouse) using your small square shader brush and a sponge.
4. Paint in the face, ears, and body of the mouse with 3 coats of Storm.
5. Using a tiny amount of Mississippi Mud and the detail brush, tap on rows of dots between the rows of texture.
6. Use your detail brush to add 1-2 heavy coats of Chiffon to the inside of the ears, the feet, and the nose.
7. Use the liner brush and fill in the tail with 1-2 heavy coats of Battleship.
8. Fill in the yamaka with 1-2 heavy coats of Blue Lagoon
9. Finally outline your entire design with Licorice, then use the back of the brush to make a tiny dot of Vanilla Bean to the eye for the twinkle

## TIPS

- When using the sponge, unload the paint onto a paper towel so that it's not a big blob of paint when you apply.
- When applying the pattern, make sure the color underneath is dry.
- Press down firmly to make sure it's transferring.
- Always peel the paper back to make sure you've transferred before removing.
- When outlining with a liner brush, hold the brush straight up and down to get thinner lines, and press down for thicker lines.

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
