CCX057 Small Wine Glass
Liner Brush
Small Brush
Detail Brush
Pencil or Water-Based Marker
NCR Flower Pattern
Red Pen



## **COLORS**

CMM 90 - Red Hot Boat CMM 18 - Pumpkin Pie CMM 46 - Sunny Side Up CMM 48 - Guacamole CMM 59 - Turquoise CMM 11 - Blue Lagoon



## INSTRUCTIONS

The Floral Fiesta Set is meant to be imperfect. From the flowers and dots, to the imperfect color, this is meant to look whimsical and handmade. Make this set your own; sketch on the flowers free hand, change up the colors. If you feel better with a pattern, there is one attached.

- 1. Use a pencil or water-based marker to sketch on the flowers. These are supposed to be imperfect and all slightly different. If you prefer, there is a pattern below. Use NCR paper to trace the flowers by pressing firmly with a pen as you trace over the design.
- 2. To begin, trace one flower about a 1/4 inch from the top rim. Then, rotate the glass around and trace another flower directly opposite the first one.
- 3. Now, rotate the glass so that the two flowers are on the right and left. Sketch a flower halfway between the first two flowers. Then, rotate the glass again and sketch a flower directly across from the last one.
- 4. Sketch a set of leaves under each of the flowers.
- 5. Sketch a line about a 1/4" underneath the leaves and then another line about 3/8" under the first one.
- 6. Paint the centers of the flowers with 2 coats of Pumpkin Pie using a detail brush.
- 7. Fill in the leaves with 2 coats of Guacamole using a liner brush.
- 8. Next, fill in the petals of the flowers with 2 coats of paint. On the blue glass, we used Red Hot for the flowers. On the red glass, we used Sunny Side Up for the flowers.
- 9. Dip the tip of a detail brush into paint and tap a row of dots above the flowers going around the top of the glass. For the blue glass, we used Blue Lagoon for the dots. For the red glass, we used Turquoise for the dots.
- 10. Paint the space around the flowers and leaves, starting under the dots and working down to the first pencil line. We used 2 coats of Turquoise for the blue glass, and 2 coats of Red Hot for the red glass.
- 11. Draw a line around the base of the glass about 1/2" in from the edge.
- 12. Use a liner brush to paint two coats of paint to both the band on the base as well as the band under the flowers. For the blue glass, we used Pumpkin Pie paint. For the red glass, we used Blue Lagoon paint.
- 13. Dip the tip of a detail brush into paint and tap a row of dots under the band on the top of the glass. For the blue glass, we used Sunny Side Up and for the red glass, we used Pumpkin Pie.
- 14. Finally, dip the tip of a detail brush into paint and tap a row of dots above the band on the base of the glass. For the blue glass, we used Red Hot for the dots. For the red glass, we used Guacamole for the dots.
