

# SEASONAL PRINTS BERRY LOVE BOWL



### MATERIALS

DB31507 Sm. Mixing Bowl Detail Brush Medium Brush Pencil or Water-Based Marker Writing Bottle Yellow Sponge Quarter

### COLORS

CMM 98- Red Head CMM 48 - Guacamole CMM 31 - Licorice

#### INSTRUCTIONS

This piece can be made with any combination of colors or number of prints. Below are the instructions for how this exact piece was made, but make it your own to fit your needs!

- 1. Use a medium brush to apply a generous coat of Red Head to the left foot. Then apply Guacamole to the toes.
- 2. Place the foot on the outside of the bowl and press firmly.
- 3. Repeat step one on the right foot and place the foot about 3" from the first foot (just making sure to leave enough room to write between the two feet).
- 4. Repeat steps 1 & 2 and place as many prints as will fit around the outside of the bowl.
- 5. Use a detail brush to apply a stem to each foot with 1 coat of Guacamole.
- 6. Sketch the sentiment with a pencil or a water-based marker.
- 7. Use a writer bottle with Licorice paint to apply the words "love you" and "much".
- 8. Then, use a writer bottle with Red Hot paint to apply the word "Berry".
- 9. Sponge 2 coats of Red Hot to the inside and rim of the bowl.
- 10. Finally, use a writer bottle with Licorice paint to apply the name.

## TIPS

- When sketching in pencil for the writing, gently rub back and forth over the pencil lines to remove excess graphite. This will make it easier to write on top of it.
- For the writing bottle, only fill the bottle 1/2 way to avoid it coming out too fast. This will help with smaller writing.
- Get the writer bottle flowing on a paper towel before you write on your piece. This will work out any air and sputtering that might occur.

\*\* These samples don't have a year painted on them, we suggest putting the year somewhere on the plate.
