IN MY NANA ERA MUG



MATERIALS

- C40003 Enamelware Mug
- Medium Brush
- Small Brush
- Fan Brush
- NCR Pattern
- Ballpoint Pen

COLORS

- CMM 19 - Banana Boat
- CMM 55 - Sea Mist
- CMM 91 - Blue Ice
- CMM 5 - Coral Reef
- CMM 16- Chiffon
- CMM 3 - Carnation

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INSTRUCTIONS

1. Thin down some Chiffon paint with 60% paint to 40% water. Use a fanbrush to apply two coats of the watered-down paint to the outside of the mug.
2. Allow the background to dry for a few minutes.
3. Apply the NCR pattern to the center of the plate by pressing firmly with a ballpoint pen as you trace over the lines.
4. Fill in the letters and flowers with 3 coats of your desired colors using a small brush. We used: Sea Mist, Banana Boat, Coral Reef, and Blue Ice.
5. Use a detail brush to fill in the centers of the flowers with 3 coats of a contrasting color from the flower.
6. Paint the handle with three coats of Blue Ice using a medium brush.
7. Use a fan brush to paint 3 coats of Carnation to the inside of the mug.

TIPS

- Three coats of paint on the letters and flowers will result in a vibrant solid color.
- If you decide to change up the colors, make sure to paint the background in a light color and the letters in darker colors. This will ensure that everything pops.
